Baptism

Jesus says in Matthew 28, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." In this gift of God's grace, by water and God's Word, God delivers us from sin and death and raises us to new life in Jesus Christ. We are united with all the baptized in the one body of Christ, anointed with the gift of the Holy Spirit, and joined in God's mission for the life of the world!

As children are brought to receive the gift of baptism, parents and guardians are entrusted with the follow **baptismal promises**: to live with them among God's faithful people, bring them to the word of God and the holy supper, teach them the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, place in their hands the holy scriptures, and nurture them in faith and prayer. **Baptismal sponsors** promise to nurture children in the Christian faith and to help them live in the covenant of baptism and in communion with the church.

Worship and Nursery

We love to all be together in worship, and children are always invited to participate with their families. As the Church, we will pray, sing, engage in children's messages, listen to God's Word, join in Holy Communion, and be sent to share God's love with the world.

In addition, our children help collect our **Noisy Offering** on the 2nd Sunday of the month; and we invite children, youth, and families to serve in leadership roles in worship!

Our sanctuary **PrayGround** is equipped with pillows, books, fidgets, and coloring materials for young children and toddlers.

Our Baby Zone has a padded mat, books, and age-appropriate toys.

Our **Nursery** is open on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings and is staffed by volunteers who have received a background check and taken our safety training.

Sunday School

Overview

Sunday School is one of our best tools for growth and spiritual development for the youngest generations at TLC, and children in preschool (3+, potty-trained) through grade 4 are invited to participate.

Through Sunday School, we fulfill the baptismal promises we make as a community to support and nurture children in their faith formation.

Every year students get to immerse themselves in Bible stories, build the foundations of their faith, be in community with one another, and experience the love of God. Each Sunday is also an opportunity for us to share two important messages that our students NEED to hear—that <u>God loves them, and we do too!</u>

Time

On Sunday mornings, parents should dropoff children in their classrooms before class and worship begin at 9:30am. The children will rejoin their families in worship during the **Sharing of the Peace** ($\sim 10:10am$).

Curriculum

- Preschoolers and kindergarteners experience the biblical story arc through Old & New Testaments stories from the **Spark Story Bible**.
- Grades 1-2 will learn those same stories through **Bible Live**, where they'll work together to create a skit of each week's story, sometimes presenting the skit in Sunday School or worship.
- Grades 3-4 will explore faith and life relational skills through our Young Samaritans program.

YOUTH MINISTRY: 5TH - 12TH GRADE

Club 567

Growing in faith doesn't end with Sunday School! It's a lifelong journey, and our youth transition to ministry programming on Wednesday nights, from 6:30-8pm.

Every night includes pizza, fellowship, large group activities, and discussions in small groups. Together, we will learn, serve, play, grow, and worship in an intentional community focused on growing in our relationships with God and each other while exploring the Bible, faith, and life.

This year, our 7^{th} grade confirmation youth will join with grades 5-6 for our **Young Samaritans** program, where they'll grow as leaders, dig deeper in their faith, and explore what it means to live out their faith in daily life.

Confirmation

Overview

Our Confirmation youth gather from 6:30-8pm on Wednesday nights for pizza, fellowship, games, small groups, service projects, and conversations about the Bible, Catechism, safe and healthy relationships, and Peer Ministry relational skills.

Throughout our three-year Confirmation program, we'll be asking and discussing big questions as we seek to better understand God, our faith, and their impact in our daily lives. As a congregation, we pray that TLC would be a place where youth can challenge, celebrate, and experience God's great love for them; that they would find a sense of belonging within the congregation while also developing a heart to serve in and outside of it; and that faith would be central to their life—now and always.

Objectives

- To experience, understand, and be affirmed in the baptismal promises of God's love.
- To gain a better understanding of the Bible and one's faith.
- To be empowered to take responsibility for one's own faith formation.

Expectations

Because Confirmation is a time for our youth to take ownership and responsibility for their own faith journey and their participation within the church, we ask our youth to:

- Attend worship regularly on Sunday mornings and Confirmation on Wednesday nights.
- Share their gifts and time in worship by greeting, ushering, lighting candles, and/or reading scripture.
- Consider signing up to be a Sunday School Teacher Assistant so they can grow as leaders.
- Serve our community and inspire our church in new ways that are meaningful to them

If an extended absence is expected, we have independent learning options for students who notify staff in advance.

Bibles

Every week we will use the CEB Study Bible during class. This Bible is given to all TLC students as they enter 7th grade and begin Confirmation (and to all new students as needed). It is meant to be used as a lifelong Bible. Please bring yours each week!

Affirmation of Baptism

At the end of their third year, confirmands are invited to affirm the promises of God that were proclaimed over them at their baptisms and to be blessed in their responsibility of continuing in their lifelong journey of faith formation as confirmed, voting members of the congregation.

In preparation for the Confirmation Worship Service, our confirmation youth will write a **Faith Statement**, have a Faith Conversation with a TLC staff member, and enjoy a special gathering with families.

Confirmation Worship will take place on Sunday, May 31, 2026.

Peer Ministry

Our high school youth will gather on Wednesdays from 6:30-8pm for pizza, fellowship, games, service, and learning. They'll experience *Peer Ministry Relational Skills* training, and the Cherish All Children Safe & Healthy Relationships Guide. This year, our 8th-9th grade confirmation youth will join with 10th-12th graders for this **Peer Ministry** learning, growing as leaders while they take ownership of their own faith journey. Peer Ministers model the faith journey and we encourage them to engage in activities with the younger children and youth in the congregation by creating a safe and welcoming space for others, and by assisting with Sunday School.

Peer Ministers will also gather one Sunday a month after worship for fellowship, learning, and service opportunities.

Wednesday Culture & Traditions

Pizza: A \$5 donation is appreciated to help cover the cost of pizza, beverages and snacks each week.

Guests: Friends are always welcome! After the first visit, we ask friends to complete our online Registration Form (please use the QR Code or go to tlcmn.com) if they'd like to continue participating.



Behavior: By participating in Wednesday night ministries, each person agrees to treat all youth and leaders with respect, to listen to each other, to help create a safe space where all people are encouraged and feel supported, and to help one another grow as Christians and as people. If students engage in inappropriate behavior, or behavior that is distracting to those around them, they may be asked to leave for the remainder of the gathering. There is zero tolerance for bullying, harassment, intimidation, or violence of any kind.

Ways for Families to Serve in CYF Ministries:

- **Nursery Assistant:** Work alongside our paid nursery staff to care for children age 5 and under during worship, 9:15-10:45am.
- **Sunday School Co-Teacher:** Partner with adults and youth to share Bible stories, play games, do crafts, and pray with children one to two times a month. Children ages 3 through grade 4 meet on Sundays at 9:30am in classrooms, and join their families in worship during the sharing of the peace.
- **PrayGround & Baby Zone:** Help keep the PrayGround and Baby Zone clean and organized and replenish supplies.
- **Wednesday Night Ministry Leader:** Join a team of adults along with Deacon Erica Larson and Pastor Joe Orner to help create a safe, welcoming and joy-filled community for 5th-12th grade youth. Wednesdays include pizza at 6:30pm, followed by community building, games, bible study, meaningful discussion, small groups, service projects and prayer, ending at 8pm.
- **Sunday High School Ministry Leader:** Join Deacon Erica Larson and the high school youth one Sunday a month following worship for food, fellowship and faith formation.
- Faith Milestone Ministry: Help create meaningful milestone experiences for children, youth and adults. A faith milestone is a marker along life's journey that says, "This is something important, and God is here, too!" Current Faith Milestones include Communion Instruction, Confirmation, and Graduation.
- **TLC Fan Club**: Cheer on our children and youth by joining the TLC Fan Club! We choose 2-4 events a month that we can attend as a group, wearing matching TLC Fan Club buttons, so that we can support and celebrate our kids at their sports, choir, band, orchestra, dance, theater, and other events. You can attend every event, or as often as time allows.
- **Lent Mentor:** Mentor a 5th-9th grade youth during the season of Lent. You'll be provided with a booklet full of topical conversation questions and meet with a mentee following Lent worship, from 7-8pm. We encourage mentors to join in worship at 6:30pm.
- Parents Night Out: We currently offer a once a month Parents Night Out, caring for children ages 0-12 while parents have a free night to do whatever they want! We'll need adult and youth helpers for these events.
- **S.W.A.T. Team:** We always need adults who can Serve Willingly, Although Temporarily (S.W.A.T.), picking up supplies, making food, helping with intergenerational events and service projects, filling in as needed!
