

Mission and Outreach Imagination Event – PACT/Center for Changing Lives Liberia

- Partnership for Community Transformation (PACT) / Center for Changing Lives – Liberia (CCLL) was formed in 2016. TLC was important in the organization of PACT becoming a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that helps support CCLL in Liberia.
- CCLL provides resources to help children who have lost parents due to Ebola or HIV and allows them to attend school. The Center also provides vocational training and counseling staff. The number of children CCLL has been able to help has grown each year (from 20 in 2016 to 75 in 2021) due to the generous support of PACT.
- Philip Nushann leads the efforts of CCLL in Liberia and many of the staff are volunteers. All of the resources from PACT fundraising go to the children and families in need.
- In addition to Pastor Arthur's active involvement with PACT, Sandy Stooke previously served on the PACT board, and Sandy Mullen is currently on the board. Many others have been involved with the annual fall fundraisers.
- In December 2019, after over a year of planning, 15 people traveled to Liberia, including 10 people from TLC. One of the main purposes of the trip was to build relationships with the Lutheran Church of Liberia and Center for Changing Lives Liberia.
- While in Liberia, our group planned and ran a 2-day camp for the children at CCLL and the neighboring community. We saw first-hand how important CCLL is to the children they serve and their future. We were also able to deliver donations to Phebe Hospital in Bong County.
- More recently, there was a generous response to the appeal for masks to fight Covid and funds to rebuild storm damaged churches in western Liberia
